

Amberley Museum & Heritage Centre – Classic Land Rover Day Sunday 15th Oct 2017 ~ Second year event at Amberley Museum~

I would like to invite you to a gathering of a wide range of Classic Land Rovers from 1948 to 1985. This event will provide an excellent opportunity to display your cherished vehicle before the winter sets in and meet with many other enthusiasts and their land rovers in the pleasant surroundings of the Museum. The models eligible are Series one – Series two and two A – Series three (all normally known as leafers). Should you have something special that you feel worthy of display that does not fall within the groups then please contact the event organiser sending a description and photo for him to make a decision on its inclusion, subject to space available

There will be three main categories for each model range and a small prize awarded to the best in category. All vehicles must be road legal and able to drive into the museum under own power. One: Cat A, most original condition including dents and scratches. Two: Cat B, most sympathetic renovation using original parts as far as possible. Three: Cat C, most interesting conversion (road legal) this will include commercial and military conversions. We will expect land rovers to arrive via road, under own power and be presented in a road worthy condition. Off-site parking is at the Amberley station and pedestrian access is by entry pathway, for modern vehicles, supporters and visitors.

The single **entry fee of £5.00 (or £5.50 with GiftAid) applies** for the vehicle, the driver, one adult passenger and any school age children arriving in the vehicle. The fee goes towards the event costs and prizes. A **concession fee of just £5.00** admission for any **additional adult** passengers, payable in advance with your entry form. Normal Museum admission rates apply to any other non-riding supporters, payable on arrival at shop.

Please note that as this is a public event, we do ask that you commit to **arriving by 10:00am** and to staying on display until the 16.30 dispersal time. Any movement on site at other times must be approved and controlled by a marshal.

Amberley Museum endeavours to be accessible to all persons including anyone with mobility difficulties but please note we are an open air, countryside site and cannot guarantee any particular parking position will be available to exhibitors. Please advise us if you are a 'blue badge' holder. In order for the public to enjoy our larger vehicle events some cars will be parked in the "White Pit"

If you would like to take part in this event, please complete the entry form opposite and **return for attn. C Wells to Museum with a stamped Self Addressed Envelope**. No applications will be accepted once our entry limits are reached. Sorry NO transported exhibits can be accepted as our space limitations give us no parking space for tender vehicles.
